How to Apply

- Complete an official application form, which can be obtained from the Admissions Office at Central Africa Christian College.
- Pay a **USD** \$5 or its equivalent in RTGS at the prevailing bank rate, Non-Refundable application fee for local students and **USD** \$10 for international students.
- Submit the completed application form together with certified copies of birth certificate, national identity document and educational certificates at the Admissions Office, the completed form should be accompanied by an original deposit slip of the Application fee or a receipt from the bursar's department (CACC). The Application fee can be deposited in the college's First Capital Bank account 21993071412 (USD) or 2199102367 (RTGS)
 - Central Africa Christian College does not have third parties who sell application forms around the country on its behalf.

Application Deadline is 28 June 2024

Entry Requirements

- For admission to programmes of study at Central Africa Christian College, for any first degree, a student must have the following qualifications in the Cambridge School examination or equivalent:
- Other than the required passes in relevant subjects at GCE A Level or equivalent, all applicants must have passed 5 'O' Level subjects or equivalent including English Language and Mathematics at grade C or Entry Requirements

Student Work Study Program

The Student Fee of \$200 per semester is in addition to tuition for all room and board students, whether registered for a 3-year diploma or a 4-year degree program. The fee is due by the end of each semester or risk being sent home.

In the event that a student is unable to pay the \$200 student fees, they may apply for the work study program at the Bursar's office.

The Student Work Study Program provides the student an opportunity to earn USD \$1.00 for every hour worked. The first 200 hours worked will be payment in full for the \$200 student fee per semester.
